Participation is limited to the first 250 artists to register online. Any MOWA member may exhibit one entry. **MOWA membership must be valid through January 31, 2023 to qualify.**

ARTWORK DROP-OFF DATES

Entries will only be accepted on the days specified below. Please review the artwork guidelines before dropping off your works.

Saturday, December 3, 2022	10:00-2:00

Artists are welcome to ship work via UPS or FedEx, provided the work arrives at the museum by Wednesday, November 30, 2022. Delivery and return of artwork via this method is at the artist's expense. Artwork should be labeled MEMBERS' SHOW and shipped to 205 Veterans Ave, West Bend, WI 53095. Please include a return shipping label in the package if artwork is being returned via UPS or FedEx at the end of the exhibition.

ARTWORK PICK-UP DATES

Entries must be picked up on the days specified below.

Thursday, January 26, 2023	10:00–6:00
Friday, January 27, 2023	10:00-4:00
Saturday, January 28, 2023	10:00-2:00

Artists unable to pick up their own work should provide written permission for the person picking up their work. Artwork will not be released without a copy of the delivery receipt with the artist's signature or a note of authorization signed by the artist.

Work not picked up on the specified dates will be considered abandoned and will be disposed of at the museum's discretion.

ARTWORK GUIDELINES

- Any two-dimensional artwork that hangs on the wall must not exceed 30" x 30" including frame
- Any three-dimensional artwork that will sit on a pedestal must not exceed 18" in any direction
- All work must be ready to install with appropriate hardware. The museum is not responsible for pieces that are damaged due to improper hanging hardware or poor craftsmanship.
- Artwork must be labeled with the artist's name, the artwork title, year created, plus whether the artwork is for sale and the asking price.
- Submitted work must have been completed in the last two years and not been exhibited previously at MOWA. All art must be created by the artist. No kits, molds or pre-stamped patterns will be accepted.
- All submitted work must remain in the exhibition for the duration of the show. No replacements or substitutions will be permitted.
- All artwork will be insured while on premises to the value stated on the entry form. In an event of a claim, the full value of the work in question will be established by insurance industry standards of fair market value.
- MOWA reserves the right to reject any work of art from public exhibition at any time.
- The museum does not take commissions for the sale of artwork. We will happily facilitate transactions between the artist and interested party. All transactions will be organized directly between the artist and buyer.
